About Zoom

- Zoom has a number of features, such as polling and breakout rooms, that help facilitate effective meetings.
- Zoom.com has a number of tutorials and instructions to help with all of these functions.
- Some to pay attention to:
 - Setting up an option that allows zoom to call participants (vs participants having to call in or join by computer) can help with bandwidth and access issues.
 - Zoom bombing: rooms can be disrupted by hackers, including those who have made racist and other inappropriate disruptions. There are a variety of ways to secure your rooms that provide varying degrees of security or limitations on functionality. For the training, ICL created a waiting room and only permitted registered participants to enter. Some trainings will also have a password.
